The capital is a modern and lively peninsula. It is the starting point of any road trip but also the right place for a quick shot at many lagoon activities, thanks to its islets >A! Or for entertainment, head for the Lemons Bay and Anse Vata >B with their cafés, restaurants, shops, nightclubs... The city centre will immerse you in the culture of the island with its historic districts, its large local market and its emblematic Coconut Trees Square >C. Only 15 minutes' drive away, pay a visit to the Tjibaou Cultural Centre >D for a glimpse of the Kanak culture and then push on to Dumbéa/ Païta, 28 km away, for a nature getaway.



The "cradle of the Kanak soul" offers you a world of thousand-year-old traditions in the midst of luscious, tropical nature! Bordered by a rugged mountainous coastline, the East Coast is unlike the rest of New Caledonia, with its lush greenery, impressive, **black** Linderalique >A rocks and authentic tribal life >B Its long and beautiful, winding roads (the Scheduled Road from Thio to Canala and especially the **Corniche Road**) offer spectacular views of the lagoon, waterfalls **(Ciu, Bâ, Tao >C)**, the famous **Hienghène's** Hen >D or the unusual Ouaième ferry >E.



From Koné to Ouégoa, the Far North offers a completely different colour scheme, from orange to pure white, with its vast, arid Land of horses and deer hunting, reminiscent of the Far West, the West Coast is distinguished by its large grassy plains and niaoulis and lunar terrain, stretching as far as the eye can see. It is not uncommon to come across wild horses on the road, which typify savannahs. That's where you can find the **«Broussards »>A** : the Caledonian cowboys who live mainly from cattle breeding and the spirit of the region. This is where the famous Heart of Voh >A, is hidden, in the mangrove swamp in the village of the same agriculture. You can meet them and sample farm produce at one of their amazing barbecues! A region steeped in history, it is name. A little further up, Koumac, famous for its annual agricultural fair, is home to limestone caves >B, suitable for climbing and home to Fort Teremba >B, a remnant from the penal colony era. Also prized for its natural beauty, it houses the Giant Fern Parc >C, caving for experts. At the far north in **Poum >C**, some more unusual places are well hidden: the **mud pools >D** and **Boat Pass >E**. the **3 Bay Trail >D** and the **Deva Domain >E** which overlooks the famous Poé lagoon.

**ROAD NETWORK** 

In line with the French highway code, you drive on the right in Caledonia, seat belts are compulsory and the roads are wellmaintained. Speed limits are generally 50 km/h in town and 110 km/h outside built-up areas. At night, stay alert as it is not uncommon to come across deer on the road. The main roads along Grande Terre (RT1 in the west and RPN3 in the east) are easy to follow. Beware of winding East Coast roads that take longer. There are no tolls and parking is only charged for in the city centre of Noumea or at La Tontouta airport.

## SERVICE STATIONS

There are many service stations in Noumea and on the West Coast, but they are fewer and farther between on the East **Coast and on the Islands.** So, remember to fill up your tank before setting off, especially on Sundays and holidays. The price of petrol does not vary from one commune to another. TIP: Don't forget to refill the tank before returning your rental.

Shops are numerous and varied in Noumea, but less so in the bush; they are **closed on Sundays** and on public holidays. Supermarkets are generally open continuously from 8am to 7pm/8pm and on Sunday mornings. The Pacific franc has a rate ixed on the euro: **1€ = 119.3XPF.**

To be able to rent a vehicle, the driver must be over 21 years old, have held a licence for more than 2 years, provide the original driver's licence, as well as an international licence, if foreign, and a credit card imprint in the name of the main driver for insurance and payment. The terms and insurances will vary according to the lessors and the category of the rented vehicle.
